
# Dear Californians,

Heartfelt thanks to all Californians for another successful year at the California State Lottery. Because of your support, 2004 was the highest sales year in California State Lottery history! Record sales of over \$2.9 billion meant that more than \$1 billion was raised for public education, for a fourth consecutive year! California's 8.3 million students received supplemental funding of \$131 per pupil from kindergarten to university level. Also, congratulations to 35 players winning \$1 million or more last year — outstanding! Additionally, the Lottery accomplished a mammoth undertaking by implementing the world's largest and most complex gaming system with more than 80,000 pieces of equipment installed in over 18,000 Lottery retailer locations.

It's hard to believe that the California State Lottery will celebrate its 20th anniversary this year! 

### Unclaimed Prizes Given to Schools

The California State Lottery collaborated with the State Controller's Office and the State Superintendent of Public Instruction to announce the transfer of \$15,064,892.53 to California's public schools at a press conference held at the Department of Education. This is the cash value of the \$28.5 million unclaimed SuperLOTTO Plus® jackpot, which expired in March 2004. This is the largest unclaimed Lottery jackpot in California's history and the 15th time a jackpot ticket has not been claimed.




